### Rural Payments Agency (RPA) - Dual Use Claims

Since early August the RPA has been contacting claimants where they believe that the Single Payment has been claimed on parcels of land whilst another claimant claims other Rural Development Schemes (e.g. ELS etc). A good example of Dual Use may be where a landlord has been claiming SPS and the tenant has been claiming ELS. For avoidance of doubt Dual Use is not the same as Dual Claim. Dual Claim, for example, would be where the landlord and the tenant claim the SPS on the same land parcels due to poor communication or agreement.

The RPA are sending letters out because the EC are investigating the RPA's interpretation and application of the scheme rules that two claimants can be eligible to apply for different CAP payment schemes on the same area of land. The RPA will have to carry out these checks on a sample of Dual Use cases this year in order for the RPA to show where different scenarios of Dual Use are possible. Unfortunately if the Commission are not convinced by the RPA's interpretation or application of Dual Use the UK is likely to suffer significant fines.

It is important that claimants reply to the letter as soon as possible to avoid delays in receiving the 2011 SPS or other scheme payments. If the RPA find a breach in eligibility rules they may stop payments and may even investigate previous years.
